

#### Introduction and Study Limits

The purpose of this Scope of Services is to detail the required study tasks for The CONSULTANT to complete for 70<sup>th</sup> Avenue traffic study. The project limits along 70<sup>th</sup> Avenue extends from 49<sup>th</sup> St to 58<sup>th</sup> Street. 70<sup>th</sup> avenue is a four-lane undivided local roadway. The total length is approximately 0.76 miles. The objective of this study is to analyze traffic capacity and the typical section of the roadway for the possibility of reducing number of lanes to one lane per direction. The CONULTANT also shall provide three Typical Sections Alternatives of the existing roadway for different options to accommodate bike lanes. The signing and pavement markings design will be updated for bike lanes consideration.

The CONSULTANT will collect engineering field observations and traffic counts, project traffic volumes to the Design Year 2045, conduct intersection traffic capacity analysis, conduct safety analysis, and present required turn lane needs at intersections. The study limits includes two signalized intersections at 58th Street and 49th Street. The project includes midblock crossing at 52nd street. A railroad crossing is included in the limits of this project.




Figure 1. Limits of the Study

#### Scope of Services:

#### 1. Data Collection and Analysis

Following the procedure in Chapter 4 of the FDOT Manual on Uniform Traffic Studies (MUTS), the CONSULTANT shall collect 24-hour traffic machine counts with bi-directional volumes, at 15-minute increments with hourly totals, at the approaches of the following intersections:

- 70th Avenue at 58th Street
- 70th Avenue at 49th Street

The traffic counters will be set-up for a period of at least 24 hours during a typical weekday (Tuesday to Thursday), which will be adjusted according to reported FDOT seasonal adjustment and axle correction factors.

The consultant shall collect 4-hour manual turning movement counts, at 15-minute increments with hourly totals at the following intersections:

- 70<sup>th</sup> Avenue at 58<sup>th</sup> Street
- 70<sup>th</sup> Avenue at 49<sup>th</sup> Street

The counts will be taken during the peak hours (a.m. peak, p.m. peak) of a typical weekday (Tuesday to Thursday) having fair weather. Manual turning movements for heavy vehicles shall be counted separately. Pedestrians and Bicycles crossing at the intersection will be counted during the same time periods as the turning movement counts.

Data collected in the field will be listed in a table format and a summary table of the collected counts will be completed and prepared as part of this task. The summary of the field data and tables will be included as an appendix of the traffic study.

#### 2. Traffic Demand Projection

70th Avenue serves commercial and retail properties as well as multiple residential communities including "The White Lake Apartments" and the "Park East Condos". The CONSULTANT shall forecast future traffic demand on the existing roads in the study area. Tampa Bay Reginal Planning Model (TBRPM) will be utilized to project future traffic volumes.

#### 3. Transportation Safety

The CONSULTANT shall examine the intersections to achieve the safest and most desirable intersection alternative. The consultant shall also examine multiple multi-modal cross-sections in the study area to provide a Complete Streets roadway that serves all modes of traffic.

#### 4. Typical Sections

The CONSULTANT shall propose three typical sections for review by the City with different configurations of one and two vehicular lane(s) along with a bicycle lane per direction. The typical sections may feature different variations of bike lanes and shared lanes for both directions of travel.

#### 5. Signing and Pavement Markings Plans

Upon selection of a typical striping section by the City, The CONSULTANT will prepare and deliver signing and pavement markings plans in accordance with the latest FDOT criteria.

#### 6. Schedule

The traffic engineering study will be completed within four months of the contract start date. Draft Traffic Study Report along with three typical section alternatives will be submitted to the City within three months of the contract start date. Upon selection of a typical striping section by the City, The CONSULTANT will prepare and deliver signing and pavement markings plans in accordance with the latest FDOT criteria and submit the Final Traffic Study Report to the City within four months of the contract start date.

#### 7. Compensation

Compensation for the above services shall be a lump sum amount of \$44,264.00.
