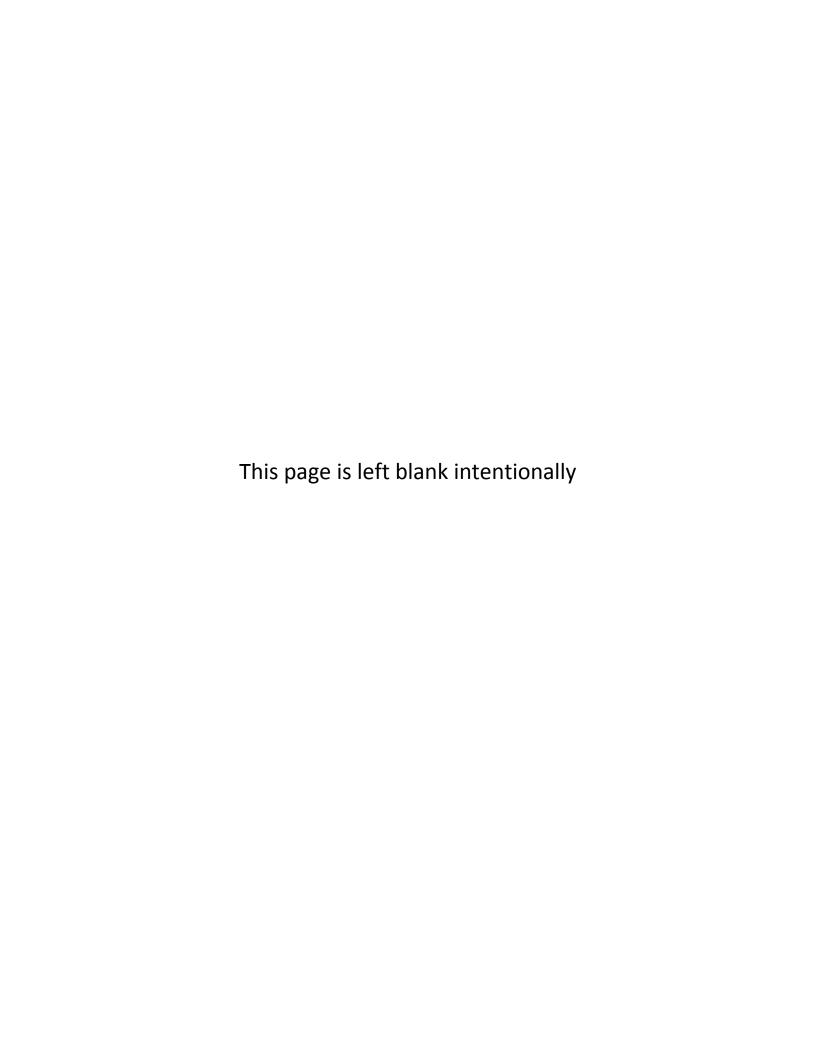

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PINELLAS PARK, FLORIDA, ANNEXING INTO THE CITY OF PINELLAS PARK, FLORIDA, A CERTAIN PARCEL OF LAND GENERALLY LOCATED AT 12880 49TH STREET NORTH, LEGALLY DESCRIBED AS ATTACHED HERETO IN EXHIBIT "A" AND MADE A PART HEREOF, LYING WITHIN SECTION 09, TOWNSHIP 30 SOUTH, RANGE 16 EAST, PINELLAS COUNTY, FLORIDA; PROVIDING FOR AMENDMENT OF THE LEGAL DESCRIPTION OF THE CORPORATE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF PINELLAS PARK, FLORIDA; PROVIDING FOR THE ASSIGNMENT OF CITY ZONING CLASSIFICATION; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES CONFLICTING HEREWITH; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Owner of a certain parcel of land lying in an unincorporated area of Pinellas County, Florida, and contiguous to the City of Pinellas Park have petitioned City Council requesting that said land be annexed into the City of Pinellas Park, Florida; and

WHEREAS, all requirements of Florida Statutes, Chapter 171, pertaining to the voluntary annexation have been complied with.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PINELLAS PARK, PINELLAS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE: That the land lying in an unincorporated area of Pinellas County, Florida, and contiguous to the City of Pinellas Park, generally located at 12880 49th Street North, and legally described as attached hereto in Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof, lying within Section 09, Township 30 South, Range 16 East, Pinellas County, Florida, is hereby annexed into the City of Pinellas Park.

SECTION TWO: That the legal description of the corporate boundaries of the City of Pinellas Park, Florida, is hereby amended to include the land herein annexed. The legal description of the City of Pinellas Park, Florida, contained in the City Charter, and all official City maps and other official documents shall be amended accordingly.

ORDINANCE NO. XXXX

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PINELLAS PARK AMENDING SECTIONS I, II, V, VI, VII and VIII OF ORDINANCE NO. 4070, AN APPROPRIATION AND TAX LEVY ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PINELLAS PARK, PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH, PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PINELLAS PARK, PINELLAS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE: That Sections I,II,V,VI,VII and VIII of Ordinance 4070 in and for the City of Pinellas Park, Florida, are amended (pursuant to the attached schedules) to read as follows:

SECTION I. GENERAL FUND

There is hereby appropriated from the revenues on hand and/or accruing from the collection of taxes levied and assessed General Fund expenses for the City for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2019, (the millage of real and personal property taxes being set at 5.4900 mills as aforesaid) and from revenues on hand and/or accruing from all other sources during the said fiscal year, and for the general operating expenses and obligations of the City of Pinellas Park during said fiscal year, in accordance with the attached budget amendment, the sum of sixty million, one hundred eighty eight thousand, eight hundred and eighty-one dollars (\$60,183,881).

- (A) All revenues under Section I of this Ordinance shall be placed exclusively in the General Fund of the City of Pinellas Park, from which the expenditures for general operating purposes, debt retirement, capital improvements and all other necessary or proper expenses shall be paid.
- (B) Revenues received or accrued for materials and/or service rendered, the volume or cost of which cannot be determined in advance so as to be included as a definite amount in the budget, for which the City is reimbursed shall be placed in the General Funds of the City and the cost of such materials and/or service shall be paid from the General Funds, and any excess of receipts above disbursements, shall become a part of the revenues of the City.

SECTION II. WATER AND SEWER REVENUE FUND

There is hereby appropriated from the "Water and Sewer Revenue Fund", of the Water and Sewerage Utility System, revenues are derived from the sale of water, water meters and installations, sewer charges, and other services rendered in connection with the operation, extension, maintenance, repair and improvement of the Water and Sewerage Utility System, in accordance with the attached budget amendment four the fiscal year ending September 30, 2019, the sum of thirty million, six hundred twenty five thousand and sixty-four dollars (\$30,625,064).

SECTION V. COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT FUND

There is hereby appropriated from the "Community Redevelopment Fund", which is created in accordance with the provisions of Section 163.387, Florida Statutes and City of Pinellas Park Ordinance Number 2047, which revenues are derived from ad valorem taxes levied by each taxing authority on taxable real property contained within the geographic boundaries of the redevelopment area for the purpose of financing the Community Redevelopment projects within the redevelopment are of the City of Pinellas Park, in accordance with the attached amendment for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2019, the sum of three million, three hundred fifty one thousand and sixty-five dollars (\$3,351,065).

SECTION VI. CAPITAL EQUIPMENT REPLACEMENT FUND

There is hereby appropriated from the "Capital Equipment Replacement Fund", which revenues are derived from transfers from the General Fund and the Water and Sewer Revenue Fund and from any and all other sources during said fiscal year, for the purpose of capital equipment replacement and internal service expenses of the City of Pinellas Park, in accordance with the budget amendment attached, for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2019, the sum of ten million, seven hundred thirty six thousand, five hundred and seventy-nine dollars (\$10,736,579).

SECTION VII. CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND

There is hereby appropriated from the "Capital Improvement Fund," which revenues are derived from transfers from the Public Improvement Revenue Fund and from any and all sources during said fiscal year, for the purpose of general capital improvement projects within the City of Pinellas Park, in accordance with the budget amendment attached, for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2019, the sum of seventeen million, two hundred fifty one thousand, four hundred and thirty-nine dollars (\$17,251,439).

SECTION VIII. INSURANCE LOSS FUND

There is hereby appropriated from the "Insurance Loss Fund", which is governed by City of Pinellas Park Resolution Numbers 79-79 and 89-34 and which revenues are derived from transfers from the General and Water and Sewer Funds and from any and all sources during said fiscal year, for the purpose of providing limited self insurance to the City of Pinellas Park, in accordance with the schedules attached for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2019, the sum of five hundred and eighty six thousand, four hundred and thirty-seven dollars (\$586,437).

SECTION TWO: Attached hereto and incorporated herein are schedules that amend Ordinance No. 4070. All Ordinances

in conflict herewith are hereby repealed insofar as the same affect this Ordinance.

SECTION THREE: The provisions of the Ordinance and any parts or sub-parts thereof shall be deemed to be severable and independent of each other, and in the event that any portion or subsection of this Ordinance is found to be invalid or unenforceable, such findings shall not affect any remaining portions of this Ordinance.

NOTE: The City of Largo owns and operates the Public Works Facility located at 1000 - 2nd Street SE in Largo, Florida which includes an area utilized by various departments and outside agencies for training purposes and to test fire pump equipment. The City of Pinellas Park Fire Department desires to use the Training Facility to conduct fire training and pump testing.

ACTION: (Approve - Deny) Authorization for City Manager to sign the Hold Harmless and Indemnification Agreement for Use of Largo Training Facility and Pump Test Site.

HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT FOR USE OF CITY OF LARGO TRAINING FACILITY AND PUMP TEST SITE

THIS HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNIFICAT	ΓΙΟΝ AGREEMENT ("Agreement") is made and entered
into on this day of	, 2019 by and between the CITY OF LARGO, FLORIDA
(hereinafter the "City") and City of Pinellas Park, FL	, (hereinafter the "User" which term shall
include, if applicable, the User's officers, agents and em	ployees).

WHEREAS, the City owns and operates the Public Works Facility located at 1000 - 2nd Street SE in Largo, Florida which includes an area utilized by various departments and outside agencies for training purposes and to test fire pump equipment (the "Training Site"); and

WHEREAS, the Training Site is available for temporary use to conduct training, pump testing and other related activities during such dates and times as is mutually agreeable to the City and the User; and

WHEREAS, the User desires to use the Training Site for the purposes of <u>Fire training and pump testing</u> (where applicable).

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. RECITALS. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.
- 2. <u>TRAINING SITE DESCRIPTION</u>. The Training Site is located on a portion of the City of Largo Public Works Facility premises and is more particularly described as follows:

Lake Largo Hammock Sub No. 1 NW 1/4, Lot 24; Parcel ID# 02/30/15/47952/200/2400 and

Lake Largo Hammock Sub No. 2 NE 1/4, Lot 25; Parcel ID# 03/30/15/47970/100/2500

It is expressly understood and agreed that User shall have access only to this portion of the City Public Works premises when conducting fire training. User shall enter and exit the Training Site only through the rear gate of the Public Works property located off of 16th Street SW except as otherwise provided herein for pump testing only.

3. <u>TERM/USE OF TRAINING SITE</u>. The Training Site, its appurtenances and fixtures, may be temporarily occupied and used by the User to conduct the aforementioned training and other related activities on the following agreed upon dates and times: <u>period beginning and ending as identified on the attached Exhibit "A"</u>.

The use of any City equipment/fixtures located at the Training Site is allowed only upon permission from the City and at the City's sole discretion. City agrees to allow User access to and use of the following equipment/fixtures located at the Training Site: Fire training tower and grounds. Pump test facilities may be used upon approval from the City and when scheduled in accordance with Section 5 below.

- 4. <u>CONDITION OF TRAINING SITE</u>. The User agrees to maintain the Training Site in a clean and useable condition and will be responsible for all reasonable, necessary and/or appropriate clean up after each use by the User. If the premises is not returned to a clean, useable condition (ordinary wear and tear excepted), as determined in the sole discretion of the City, the City reserves the right to repair, cleanup, and restore the Training Site and the full cost of said repair, cleanup and/or restoration shall be paid by the User to the City within ten (10) days of receipt of an invoice from the City.

User's liability hereunder shall include all attorney's fees and costs incurred by the City in the enforcement of this indemnification provision. indemnification includes claims made by the employees of the User against the City and the User hereby waives its entitlement, if any, to immunity under Section 440.11, Florida Statutes. The obligations contained in this provision shall not be limited by the amount of any insurance required to be obtained or maintained under this Agreement. This provision shall survive the termination of this Agreement and User's use of the Training Site and the City's equipment and facilities.

(b) If User is a private entity, User agrees as follows with respect to its use and occupancy of the Training Site:

The parties recognize that the User is an independent contractor. User assumes all risks and hazards incidental to User's use and occupation of the Training Site and participation in activities and use of equipment and facilities of the City and does hereby agree to waive, release, absolve, indemnify, defend and hold harmless the City, its commissioners, mayor, officers, employees, agents and attorneys of, from and against all liability and expense, including reasonable attorney's fees, in connection with any and all claims, demands, damages, actions, causes of action, and suits in equity of whatever kind or nature, including claims for personal injury, property damage, equitable relief, or loss of use, arising out of User's use and occupation of the Training Site and the User's use of the equipment and facilities of the City. User's liability hereunder shall include all attorney's fees and costs incurred by the City in the enforcement

of this indemnification provision. In the event User does, in fact, invite a third party or utilizes the services of a third party for training purposes, User agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the City from any damage or claims which may result from the acts or omissions of the third party, and said obligation to indemnify and hold harmless shall be subject to the terms of Section 6 above. The City reserves the right to deny access to any third party in its sole discretion.
- 8. <u>ASSUMPTION OF THE RISK</u>. Participation in the training and use of the Training Site contemplated by this Agreement may carry certain inherent risks or dangers of which a reasonably prudent person should be aware. To that extent, User acknowledges and agrees and hereby assumes the risks associated with the training activities contemplated herein and the use of said Training Site.
- 9. <u>TERMINATION</u>. This Agreement shall remain in full force and effect until terminated by any party hereto. This Agreement may be terminated immediately, without cause, by a party hereto upon giving written notice thereof to the other party.
- 10. <u>REGULATION COMPLIANCE</u>. During the performance of this Agreement, User agrees to abide by any and all administrative, operational, and safety rules and regulations established by the City, its agents and/or employees during the use and occupation of the Training Site by the User. Any breach of any rule or regulation established by the City shall result in an immediate termination of the use of the Training Site and, in the City's sole discretion, termination of this Agreement.
- 11. <u>COUNTERPARTS</u>. This Agreement may be executed in any number of counterparts, each of which when executed and delivered shall constitute a duplicate original, but all counterparts together shall constitute a single Agreement.
