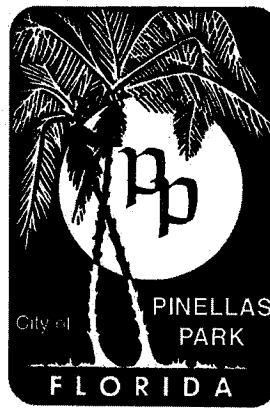

Dear Mr. Arrison:

I have received and reviewed the above-referenced Contract, which is proposed to be a piggyback of Pinellas County Bid/Contract #189-0118-CP(JJ) with MTM Contractors Inc.

After review of all the items sent to our office, and a review of Pinellas Park's bid requirements in Section 2-602 of the City's Code of Ordinances, it would appear that the Contract between Pinellas County and MTM Contractors Inc, was secured through a competitive bidding process which is equal to or more stringent than the competitive bidding process required by Pinellas Park City Code. The memorandum provided by the Purchasing Department confirms they also believe this Contract may be piggybacked.

As long as the items or services that the City wishes to secure from MTM Contractors Inc, are substantially similar and their pricing is in accordance with the pricing provided in the Pinellas County Contract, I am of the opinion that the Contract from Pinellas County is able to be piggybacked. I would approve of the Proposed Contract for Curb Replacement as to form and correctness.


