

Good afternoon Gary,

There are conditions at [6381 82nd Avenue](#) which qualify for potential risks to health and safety. The roadway has begun to sink in the west bound lane the Sewer main is approximately 18 feet in depth . The estimated cost for this repair could be \$96,000.00 to include bye-pass pumping of our 30" gravity main.

BLD Services has agreed to make internal repair lining. Your office has previously approved the piggyback contract they have with the City of Largo.

As discussed, the condition at the connection of the lateral is in bad shape, BLD Services will do our best to clean and line the lateral. BLD cannot be responsible if the lateral collapses during the cleaning process. Also, we cannot guarantee that we will stop the leak, once lined the pipe will be structurally sound.

Proposal Inclusions:

- Certificate of Insurance with standard coverage
- Post-Installation video of scheduled repairs and mainlines

Proposal Exclusions:

- Premiums for special insurance coverage requirements
- Reinstatement / re-brushing of service connections
- **CLEAN-OUT INSTALLATION**

Proposal Terms:

- All Items quoted are to be considered inclusive of this proposal, no separation of any one pay item should be assumed, i.e., TV inspection and cleaning item will be provided by BLD Services, LLC as part of the CIPP Lateral Lining portion of this project.
- Payment due within 30 days of completion of BLD's portion of the project
- Partial monthly payments may be requested
- Proposal valid for 60 days

Special Conditions:

- General Contractor will be required to provide access to all manholes
- General Contract will be required to provide post videos of CIPP lining prior to mobilization for lateral identification
- General Contractor will provide notification / flyers if required by owner – BLD will distribute
- General Contractor provide all traffic control devices and permits beyond typical traffic cones and signs carried by crew
- General contractor to provide bypass pumping above 12" mainline pipe
- General contractor will provide water meter if required by owner and pay all cost for water.

Mutual Release of Consequential Damages:

Neither party shall be liable to the other for consequential damages relating to or arising out of this Contract.
