RESOLUTION NO. 20-03. A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION 19-06 OF THE CITY OF PINELLAS PARK, FLORIDA, PROVIDING FOR AN EXTENDED EXPIRATION DATE FOR THE PARTIAL REDUCTION IN LAND DEVELOPMENT FEES AS OUTLINED IN EXHIBIT "A", ATTACHED HERETO AND MADE A PART HEREOF, FOR ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT ACTIVITIES ASSOCIATED WITH THE EXPANSION OF BECKWITH ELECTRIC CO., INC., AND THE REDEVELOPMENT OF THE PROPERTY LOCATED AT 6190 118TH AVENUE NORTH; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

FIRST AND FINAL READING

NOTE: On February 14, 2019, City Council approved a waiver of land development fees for Beckwith Electric Co., Inc.'s expansion, in the amount of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000). Due to unforeseen delays with Pinellas County for drainage/runoffs and easement acquisitions, Beckwith Electric Co., Inc., is requesting the expiration date of the fee waiver, which is February 13, 2020, be extended an additional year to February 12, 2021.
